'Fall' Offering – Oct. 14

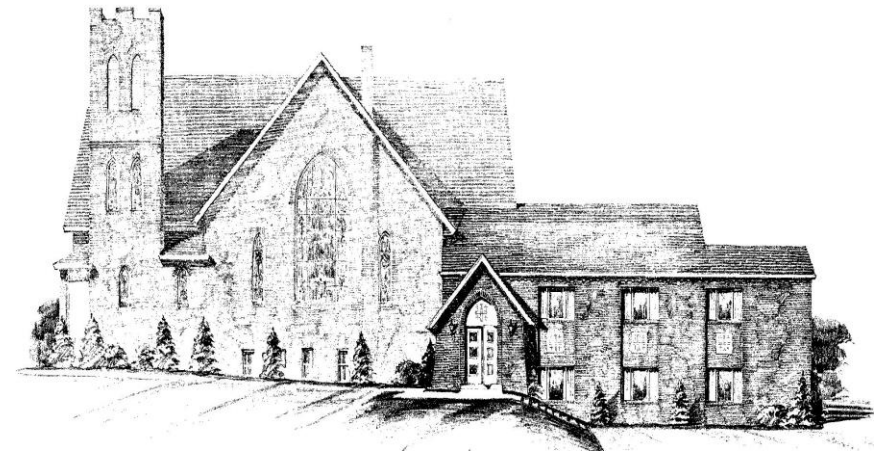
