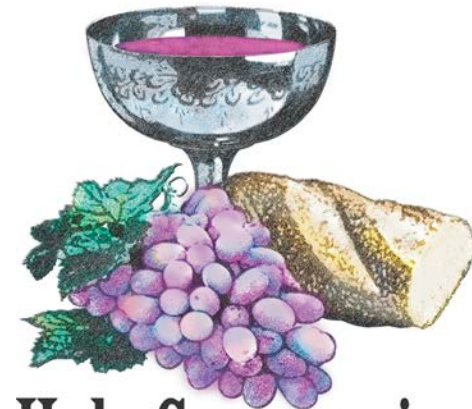
The Session has called a Congregational meeting for after worship on Sunday, December 9, 2018. The purpose of this meeting is the election of officers.
