# The Way to a Unified Church Ephesians 4: 1-6

I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all.

The Ephesian church was experiencing some of the difficulties of not being unified. Among the leadership of the Ephesian church existed a bit of confusion as to the direction of the church. There was also some confusion as to how the Ephesian church should be living out the gospel. These are some of the possible issues the Apostle Paul wanted to focus on.

The Apostle Paul shared the following with the Ephesian Church. "I beg you to live a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity in the bond of peace. We can hear the passion of Paul while calling the Ephesian church from being divided to being unified. Let's examine the Apostle Paul's remedy to division.

First, the Apostle Paul encourages unity through the characteristics of humility and gentleness. Humility is the foundation of all virtue. Humility is the absence of arrogance and mean-spiritedness. Paul was asking the Ephesian church to work with each other from a position of humility not arrogance.

Second, the Apostle Paul encourages unity through the characteristic of patience. Patience exists in bearing any adverse circumstance that may arise. The exercising of patience teaches us how to respond to suffering. This can tie unity together when unity is needed the most.

Finally, the Apostle Paul encourages unity through the characteristic of forbearing one another in love. This characteristic translates into being faithful during difficult times. God's people have the deepest need to forbear one another. It is the ability to suffer with one another during troubled times. These are the ways the unity of the spirit is maintained.

The Ephesian church was experiencing difficulties to being unified. The Apostle Paul boils down some characteristics that would eventually lead to unity of purpose. Humility, gentleness, patience and forbearing one another in love could mend the divide that existed within the Ephesian church. The characteristics discussed would eventually lead to maintaining unity in the bond of peace.
