"Help in Our Weakness" Roman 8:26-30

²⁶Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. ²⁷ And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God. ²⁸ And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. ²⁹ For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. ³⁰ And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he justified he also glorified.

We don't like asking for help. Think about it. We go into a grocery store and look up at the signs for the item you want. It usually takes us a few moments before we go to a store clerk and ask for help in getting the item we want.

In our text, the Apostle Paul is writing to the church in Rome and encouraging the church to rely on the Holy Spirit in times of weakness. The word weakness is defined as weakness of the flesh, unimpressive in appearance, and refers to sickness.

I think sickness is a good word for our purposes because sin is sickness to the soul. Paul was reminding the church in Rome that they have been saved by Jesus Christ and that the Holy Spirit was given to them to strengthen them in their sinful weaknesses as well as aiding them in their prayers.

Ponder this for a moment. God who created the universe is the same God who walks in your everyday life. This same God who establishes the boundaries of the earth is the same God who promises that He will never leave you or forsake you. This God, through the power of the Holy Spirit, is with you as you read this article. The Spirit of God will help you through the ups and downs of life. He will be with you when you ignore him. The Holy Spirit will be with you when you acknowledge Him. The Holy Spirit is our helper and supporter.

Don't be afraid to ask for help from the Holy Spirit. He is there to assist you through the different challenges of life. Ask His help today.
