Mark 5: 19-20

19 However, Jesus did not permit him, but said to him, "Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has had compassion on you." 20 And he departed and began to proclaim in Decapolis all that Jesus had done for him, and all marveled.

The circumstance referenced above is truly mind-blowing. This man was possessed by a legion of evil spirits. A legion consists of three thousand to six thousand soldiers, which means this poor soul was filled with at least three thousand demons, all within one body.

Out of extreme gratitude for his deliverance from such a multitude of demons, the man wanted to follow Jesus. This desire is understandable given his experience. However, Jesus told him, "No. Go home to your friends and tell them how great things the Lord has done for you and how He has had compassion on you."


