Galatians 6:2

"Bear one another's burdens, and thus fulfill the law of Christ."

What exactly does Galatians 6:2 mean when it tells us to "bear one another's burdens"? I think it does not only mean to tolerate each other, or put up with each other, but to shoulder each other's burdens.

The word burden means to bear another's unbearable load. It is a load that one person can't carry by themselves. We can bear one another's burdens because two people bearing a load can shoulder an unbearable load. It is our spiritual responsibility to bear our brother's or sister's unbearable load.

One significant way to do this is to engage in meaningful conversations with the person bearing the load and to pray for them regularly. This spiritual support is invaluable and can help our brothers and sisters with the issues they may be shouldering or the sins they may be trying to overcome.

Someone you know may be shouldering an unbearable burden. Perhaps it is God's call for you to help them bear that burden. Let's be sensitive to the brothers and sisters around us through the Spirit. They may need your shoulder to lean on. Let this be our inspiration to act.
